# SUCCESSFUL STUDENTS / INSPIRING TEACHERS

Our recent NAPLAN results have revealed that the number of PCPS students achieving in the top 2 bands of NAPLAN have improved each year for the past three years especially in the area of Reading. In 2016, we had 30.6% of our Year 5 students in the top two bands. In 2017, we had 38.6% of our Year 5 students in the top two bands and in 2018, we have had 43.5% of our students make this same benchmark. Compared to similar schools and the State average, our Year 5



students are averaging results 8% higher. Well done to all of the staff and students who have worked hard to put our school in this position!

One of the greatest things about our school other than academic skill development is that we offer our students a wide range of curricula and extra curricula opportunities. I am frequently amazed by the clever artworks that the students produce in their classes. A terrific example is the mixed media picture shown. Absolutely fantastic work! Keep it up everyone!

Any un-named Lost Property remaining after Wednesday, Week 3, October 31st, will be disposed of.





Primary Ethics is the organisation that runs ethics classes at our school. Their latest newsletter covers some of the topics students are currently discussing in ethics classes. Read about it here:




