## EXTERNAL VALIDATION (EV)

Each year, schools will assess their practices against the Framework to inform their school plans and annual reports. The description of excellence in the Framework supports schools as they engage their communities in the development of a shared vision, the identification of strategic priorities, and the ongoing tracking of progress towards them. The panel will meet with our EV submission team of myself, Mrs Young, Mr Johnston & Miss Nicholson. We will share the findings of this process in the coming week.

## KINDERGARTEN TRANSITION

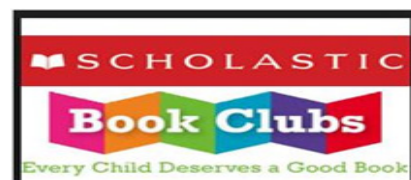
