Point Clare Public School has achieved many fabulous achievements in what has been the most disrupted year anyone of us could have ever imagined. On behalf of the staff I want to express my sincere gratitude to our whole school community for getting right behind the school. Your continued support has helped us to support the students in ways many of us couldn't have even considered possible a year ago. I want to thank the admin team, our cleaners, our School Learning Support Officers and every teacher in our school for showing great resilience and perseverance in an extremely tough working environment during the COVID-19 pandemic. You are all heroes in my books. My thanks also go out to the P & C for supporting the school in the hardest ever year to conduct fundraising. We are hugely appreciative of the contributions and donations throughout the year for the school band, the home readers, the sustainable gardens support and the assistance with the new Prowise interactive panels for Stage 1. We look forward to working with you again in 2021.

Our three-year 'Visible Learning' school improvement program run in conjunction with Empire Bay PS has helped our school to embed a goal setting culture that is owned and driven by the teachers and the students. This ownership has once again created fabulous results right across the school.

Academically, this year we had the "Check-In" Assessments for Years 3 & 5 which replaced NAPLAN for one year. Our results for these literacy and numeracy assessments confirm that the school continues to produce impressive results with the average achievement of both year groups well above both NSW average and the Similar Schools Group (SSG) average. In Kindergarten, we have maintained our 5 year average of at least 92% of students achieving above the expected Reading benchmark by the end of the year. These results are the product of a strong school learning culture that is driven by excellent teachers and highly engaged learners.

Finally, my sincere congratulations go out to our outgoing and very talented Year 6 students. You have individually and collectively achieved so many great things in your years at Point Clare Public School. You will be most definitely fondly remembered. We wish you all the best for high school and look forward to hearing all about your achievements in the near future. No doubt there will be many!


