### **OPPORTUNITY CLASS TESTS**

This coming Wednesday we have the OC tests being conducted in our school with nine of our students sitting for the assessments. The tests will be supervised by Mrs Roberts and have very strict procedures. All students involved will today be given a reminder sheet of information for all parents and families. It is very important that all nine candidates adhere to the information provided below:

#### 6. What must the students bring to the test?

Students MUST bring a printed copy of their 'Test authority' letter showing their application number.			
Students who have been granted disability provisions must bring any specially approved items.			
Students SHOULD bring to the test room:	Students SHOULD NOT bring to the test room:		
Glasses, asthma inhaler and tissues, if required. Any other medical equipment must be approved before the test.	Pens, pencils, pencil cases, erasers, note paper or other material such as dictionaries or books.		
Clear plastic water bottle – with no writing on it except for the brand name (to be stored under the seat to avoid spills).	Equipment such as rulers, calculators, computers, mobile phones, computer watches, watches that calculate or beep or any device that calculates, photographs or communicates.		

Pens will be provided for all students sitting the test.

#### **END OF YEAR PRESENTATIONS**

This year due to our inability to have parents and carers on site, we are implementing a major change to our end of year Presentation Days. This year we will still announce the 2021 school leaders on the day but the formal induction process will now be conducted at a separate ceremony held early in Term 1 - 2021. We are hoping that the current restrictions will be lifted so that we can have parents and carers on site to pin the leadership badges onto each student. The recording of the various parts of the Presentation Days will take place over the next few weeks and will then be edited together with the live awards ceremonies later in the term.

#### **MOBILE RECEPTION**

The school has been actively chasing quotes from both Telstra and Optus for several months now to try to improve mobile reception on our school site. Mobile reception is virtually zero once you enter the administration new block. This is a huge issue in terms of WH&S and there are no funds provided by DET to support the rectification. This lack of telephone coverage has caused ongoing frustration for all staff and visitors to the school. We have had TELSTRA technicians on site to do an audit of the building and the projected costs for their installation of 4 Yagi + Stationary TGO aerials plus cabling and labour is \$10,375.40 (inc G.S.T.)

#### **STAFFING UPDATE**

Our recent AP panel has submitted the job advertisement for our next Assistant Principal to replace Mrs Jennifer Ricketts at the end of Term 1 next year. Mrs Ricketts has had a long and distinguished career as an educator in the NSW Public Education system and will be sorely missed by the Point Clare Public School community. The panel will meet within the next ten days to interview applicants and finalise this process.

#### WASTE AUDIT

On Wednesday 4 November, Point Clare School students did a waste audit. We collected all the rubbish on Tuesday and sorted it out into groups; fruit scraps, soft plastics, 10 cent bottles, general waste, green bin and yellow bin. A Rumbalara Environmental Education teacher came and weighed our rubbish. We listened to a talk and watched a hilarious video.

We also listened to some noises of birds and learnt about endangered species from a teacher from the Department of the Environment. Everyone got into groups and did a fun sorting game to match those species of birds. Outside the library Mrs Arkell ran a lesson on what should go in our bins. Mrs Bain had an activity on the Prowise board about classifying plastics as short use, long use, necessary and unnecessary. Mr Rayner showed us how long certain materials take to break down in the ground. He did this by using a timeline. After lunch Stage 2 Green went out and collected materials in the nature garden and made a natural collage. Some Stage 2 classes collected rubbish to save our environment. On Friday, Stage 2 Green listened to a presentation on the native bees and watched the hive being opened.



## Transport Access Program Point Clare Station Upgrade Have your say

### The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Point Clare Station


Planning is underway to improve accessibility at Point Clare Station. The upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

### Key features of the proposed upgrade include:

- two new lifts connecting each platform to the commuter car parks
- new stairs from Brisbane Water Drive to Platform 2
- new ramps on Brisbane Water Drive and Kurrawa Avenue to connect to the station underpass
- new stairs from Kurrawa Avenue entry to the station underpass
- two new accessible parking spaces and a kiss and ride space in the Brisbane Water Drive commuter car park
- one new accessible parking space and a kiss and ride space in the Kurrawa Avenue commuter car park

- upgraded bus stop waiting area including seating and tactiles on Brisbane Water Drive
- upgrade pathways around the station precinct
- upgrade the existing toilets to provide a new family accessible toilet and a new unisex ambulant toilet
- minor platform regrading and installation of new tactiles where required
- reconfigured bicycle parking on Brisbane Water Drive
- improvement to lighting, electricity supply, wayfinding and CCTV.
