
OPAL CARD RENEWALS

Applications for student travel in 2021 opened on Monday 12 October 2020. Students who require a new School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now apply online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g., joint custody). Students who have changed school/campus, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should re-apply or update their details. Applications need to be submitted before 31 December 2020 to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

KINDERGARTEN 2021 - BEST START INTERVIEWS

Tomorrow our BEST START INTERVIEW booking system will go live with a link provided to each family via email. All parents will be able to book one (1) forty-minute interview session for their child on either Friday 29 January, Monday 1 February or Tuesday 2 February with their allocated 2021 class teacher. Each teacher has only allocated sufficient slots for each family so we ask that you only select one slot. This is done by selecting the starting box of each time period as shown in the image below. This will then provide a pop-up box that allows you to enter some simple information.

COVID INTENSIVE LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAM

The NSW Department of Education has announced the \$337 million COVID intensive learning support program which aims to employ 5,500 teachers and educators in schools across the state throughout 2021. I am pleased to announce that Point Clare Public School has been awarded \$130,291.41 in funding to support this program. We will provide greater detail in Term 1 next year about how this funding will be utilised in our school.


LATEST COVID-19 ADVICE FOR FAMILIES - YEAR 6 FAREWELL

Our Stage 3 team have done a marvellous job of co-ordinating the 2020 Year 6 Farewell. With the guidelines sometimes changing on a daily basis, it has been a real juggling act for the Stage 3 team. I really admire how cleverly they have managed to pull together such a great event in such difficult circumstances. Tonight, I am absolutely certain that the Year 6 students will have a great time together and we will ensure that many photos are available for the families to view afterwards.

Schools have guidelines in place for school organised formals which include the requirement of a COVID-19 Safety Plan. Students and their parents and carers need to be aware of the following for school organised formals:

- Attendance is limited to the student cohort and supervising staff only
- If the venue has the capacity, the school can decide to allow the attendance of external visitors such as partners, DJs, and photographers. The school will need to consider and follow the current safety guidelines which includes:
 - Signing in with an external visitor form
 - ensuring the venue has the capacity to maintain the 4 square metre rule for each attendee.
 - Maximum of 30 attendees per table
 - Students and/or guests will not be allowed to congregate or crowd in groups including when arriving or leaving the event
 - Dance floors are allowed and should be held outside if possible. If a dance floor is indoors, ensure it is well ventilated
 - There must be sufficient room for 1.5 metres physical distancing
