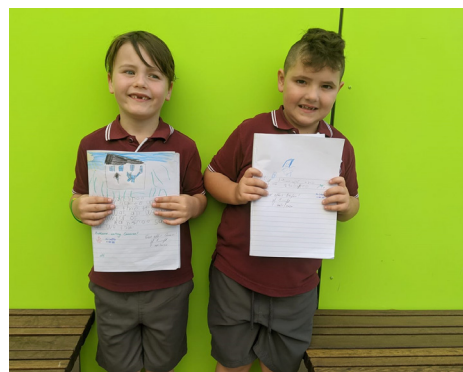
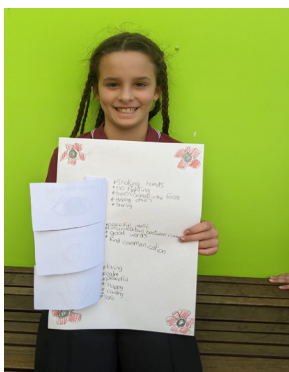

SUCCESSFUL STUDENTS

I am very happy to report that even though we are rapidly approaching the end of the school year, I can still see high levels of engagement in the classrooms and a high standard in the various work samples from the children who come to see me each week for their Principal awards. Over the past week I have seen a lot of excellent pieces of writing. Part of the 7 Steps to Writing program teaches the students to use 'dynamic dialogue' and I have read some quality efforts from all Stages recently. Even more pleasing has been the increased focus on 'personal responsibility' as part of our PBL program. We have seen at least a 50% reduction in the amount of lost property in the last two school weeks which is extremely satisfying. Teaching children to be responsible for their belongings is something that we all have a shared ownership of. Let's hope we can see this trend continue for the remainder of the term.

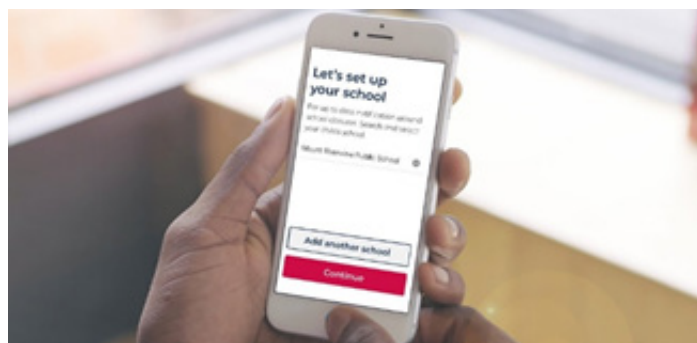


NSW SCHOOL UPDATES APP

The NSW School Updates app allows parents and carers to receive operational status updates for NSW Public Schools. The app will complement the other means of communication available to parents and carers from schools and the Department of Education to ensure families receive timely, accurate information in a crisis. The app is free and available now for iOS and Android users. We believe this will be very beneficial for many families trying to co-ordinate their movements as we approach bushfire season.

BUSHFIRES - TEMPORARILY CEASING OPERATIONS

If our school determines that a decision to temporarily cease operations is appropriate for an emergency situation, including natural disasters such as bushfire or flood, we are required to make contact with the Health and Safety Directorate to provide details. This will also allow the Department to fulfil its obligations for advising the State Emergency Operations Centre (SEOC) of any temporary closures during an emergency event.

We will also advise the school community via a number of means including our current Skoolbag app, our Facebook page and our school webpage. In addition to this, if the school has to temporarily cease operations for a day or more, each Stage team has already prepared a remote learning environment for the students to support and continue their education. The links for these environments will be released only when required and this will be via our above stated social media platforms.

VOLUNTARY SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 2021

The NSW Department of Education has advised that voluntary contribution rates are to be maintained at \$108 for secondary school students and \$50 for primary school students. At Point Clare Public School we will maintain our 2020 contribution at \$40 per student or family contribution of Child 1 - \$40, Child 2 - \$30, Child 3 - \$10 and Child 4 - \$0. In addition to voluntary school contributions, schools are able to seek subject-specific contributions from parents and these will be determined early in the 2021 school year for each Stage of learning.

One of our long term temporary teachers – Mrs Trish Arkell has recently been successful at interview and will next year commence a permanent role at Gosford East Public School. Mrs Arkell has been an excellent team member and a wonderful teacher over many years at Point Clare Public School. 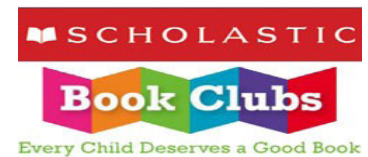
