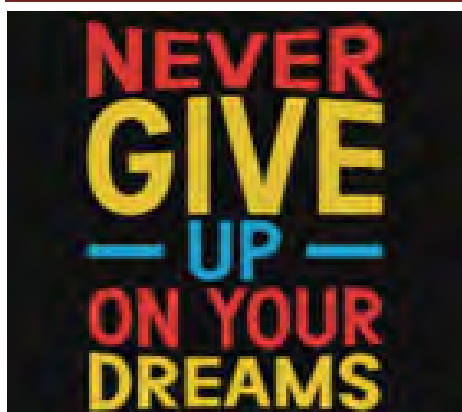


## SUCCESSFUL STUDENTS

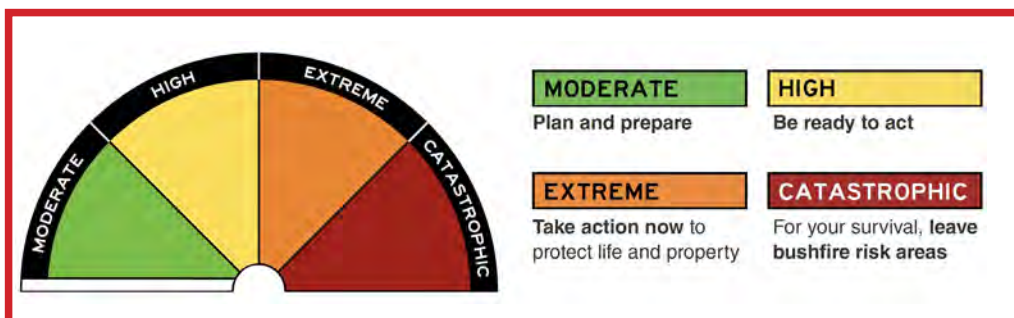
## BUSHFIRE PREPARATION

Our school is in the Greater Sydney Region which is a bushfire prone area and is identified as Category 2 on the NSW Department of Education's bushfire risk register. This means our school will be non-operational when the NSW Rural Fire Service declares catastrophic fire danger ratings for the Greater Sydney Region or as directed by the NSW Department of Education in consultation with emergency services due to local bushfire activity or in higher risk conditions.

If we advise that the school is going to be non-operational all classes will move immediately to the google classroom remote learning model. If you have any issues with accessing your google classroom please contact your child's classroom teacher via the **SENTRAL** app.
