

SUCCESSFUL STAFF

Congratulations to our three latest outstanding aspiring leaders in Mrs Cahill, Mrs Warren and Mr Amos who all completed their 12-month Path 2 Leadership (P2L) program last Friday at Mingara Recreation Club. The P2L program is designed and delivered by a core group of Central Coast primary and high school principals and deputy principals with the aim being that we give our aspiring leaders a year's worth of professional learning to prepare them for the next step in their careers. Each candidate has to deliver a presentation relating to the impact of a whole of school improvement activity that they have led. All three candidates did a fantastic job and represented our school with distinction. It was really wonderful to actually be there in person to watch their presentations and see them awarded with their graduation certificates.



CLASS REQUESTS 2025 - REPEAT

Over the past seven (7) years we have worked extremely hard to collaborate with our community to accurately form our classes for each stage of learning. A great deal of thinking is involved in forming classes with teacher and parental input, academic achievement, behavioural considerations, reasonable adjustments for learning difficulties, health conditions, teaching styles and available physical spaces all being taken into consideration before any student is placed in any class. The whole process takes up two full weeks this term and is usually not resolved until the second week back in Term 1 next year.

This year we are asking that all families refine the focus of their class requests to considerations around your child or children's specific educational needs, health care supports and preferences for potential learning spaces. Additionally, all requests for individual class teachers for 2025 will not be considered due to retirements and several members of the teaching staff changing to different stages of learning. All requests must be submitted via the google form link provided below for consideration.

The following google link will remain open until 4pm on Friday 22 November at which point it will be locked so that the teachers can begin the process of assigning classes.

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT DAYS 2025

School Development Days are designed to build a world class public education system through the roll out of the new knowledge-based curriculum which embeds explicit teaching in every classroom. At the start of 2025, our teachers now have four (4) development days, and all students K-6 will commence learning on Thursday 6 February 2025. Our incoming Kindergarten students will have their Best Start assessments conducted at some point in the first 5 weeks of Term 1. The Department of Education will provide more specific guidance on that process shortly.
